CHILD ABUSE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS
REPORTING CHILD ABUSE IN VIRGINIA**

When reporting child abuse of any kind, a call should be made immediately and within 72 hours to the Department of Social Services, Child Protective Services in the locality (City/Town or County) where the abuse occurred, not where the child resides.

- Information given should include:*
- Name of child, birth date if possible*
- Home Address of Child*
- Home Phone # of Child*
- Name of abuser*
- Birth date if possible*
- Social Security # if possible*
- Home Address of the abuser*
- Physical description of the abuser, if possible*

Give as much complete information as you can obtain, this will help in the investigation.

CONTACTING THE COUNCIL

Email, fax or mail the “Suspected Child Abuse Reported Form” to the attention of James Milham, Scout Executive – Stonewall Jackson Area Council. (Contact information below)

All reports of child abuse are confidential. A report of any suspected Child Abuse should be immediately reported to the Scout Executive of the Stonewall Jackson Area Council verbally and in writing detailing as much information as possible within 72 hours.
