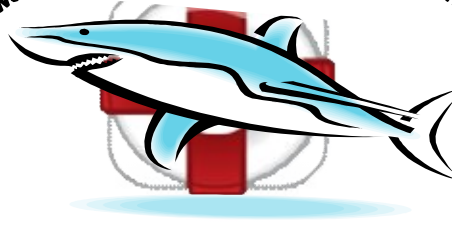




Stonewall Jackson Area Council Aquatics Committee



--JUNE 6TH AND 7TH AT CAMP SHENANDOAH --

New Training Available: BSA Aquatics Supervision. A new training program, BSA Aquatics Supervision has been developed to provide leaders with appropriate skills for conducting aquatics activities in and on the water. There are two courses associated with BSA Aquatics Supervision; Swimming and Water Rescue and Paddle Craft Safety. The minimum age to take the courses is 16. The prerequisite for the classes are to be able to pass the BSA Swimmer’s test, have Class I Physical, and be able to recover a 10 lb. weight from 8 ft of water. The course is not designed to be a physical challenge, but one must be able to perform the skills presented in the course in order to complete the training.

The Stonewall Jackson Local Aquatics Committee will be offering the training for both the Swimming and Water Rescue and Paddle Craft Safety. Paddle Craft Safety will be offered on Saturday June 6th at Camp Shenandoah, 8am – 6pm. Swimming and Water Rescue will be offered on Sunday June 7th, 8am – 6pm. There will be a charge of \$15 for each course and lunch will be provided. Each participant will be required to have a copy of the Aquatic Supervision manual.
